



Data and Compliance Note

hPOD Preventive Health Screening Platform — Beacon Health Limited

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This document is intended for organisations, institutions, and program partners evaluating or deploying hPOD-enabled preventive health screening programs through Beacon Health Limited. It sets out how health data is collected, stored, protected, and governed across Beacon Health deployments — and the responsibilities that apply to individuals, deploying organisations, and Beacon Health as program operator. This note should be read alongside any applicable local privacy regulations and the terms governing your specific deployment agreement.

DATA COLLECTION AND CONSENT

- All health data is collected with the explicit, informed consent of the individual prior to screening. Participation is voluntary at every stage.
- Data collected includes physiological parameters, screening results, and where applicable, basic demographic identifiers required for record creation.
- No data is collected beyond what is necessary for the specific screening program in which the individual is participating.
- Individuals retain ownership and control of their personal health records at all times. Records may only be shared with third parties when explicitly authorised by the individual.
- Consent may be withdrawn at any point. Individuals may request access to, correction of, or deletion of their records in accordance with applicable local privacy requirements.

DATA STORAGE AND SECURITY

- Health data collected through hPOD is processed and stored on secure cloud infrastructure operated by India Health Link (IHL), Beacon Health's OEM technology partner. Where applicable local laws require data to remain within national boundaries, Beacon Health is committed to adopting compliant in-country storage arrangements.
- All data is protected by end-to-end encryption, both at rest and in transit, in accordance with IHL's HIPAA-aligned, privacy-by-design architecture.
- Data sovereignty is maintained through IHL's hosting infrastructure, designed to meet applicable data residency and security standards across deployment geographies.
- Access to individual health records is role-based and strictly controlled. Organisational access is limited to anonymised, aggregated cohort-level insights through the program portal.
- Beacon Health operates as the program delivery layer and does not independently store, process, or transfer individual health data outside the governance framework established by IHL's platform.



Regulatory Standing, Rights and Governance

- The platform is designed in accordance with applicable medical device, data protection, and security standards across the geographies in which it is deployed.
- Beacon Health deploys hPOD within a structured program governance framework, ensuring deployments align with local regulatory expectations, clinical governance requirements, and institutional compliance obligations.
- Thermalytix, the AI-assisted breast health screening capability integrated within hPOD, is FDA-cleared and developed by Niramai — an independent medical AI partner operating under its own regulatory standing.
- Beacon Health maintains deployment records, governance documentation, and program reporting to support audit readiness and compliance transparency for deploying organisations.

RIGHTS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND GOVERNANCE

Individual Rights

- Every individual has the right to access, review, and request correction of their personal health records at any time.
- Individuals may withdraw consent and request deletion of their data in accordance with applicable local privacy requirements.
- Screening results are provided directly to the individual and are not shared with employers, insurers, or third parties without explicit consent.

Deploying Organisation Responsibilities

- Deploying organisations are responsible for ensuring participants are informed of the nature and purpose of the screening program prior to participation.
- Organisations must appoint a designated contact responsible for program governance, data queries, and escalation within their environment.
- Organisations must not use aggregated cohort insights for purposes beyond those agreed in the deployment program scope.

Beacon Health's Role

- Beacon Health operates as program delivery partner and governance layer, ensuring deployments are conducted responsibly, transparently, and in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements.
